

NEPA Surges Ahead

NEPA Limited having a low production level between 20000 MT to 22000 MT for past three years, has taken a quantum jump in the field of production and sales during the current financial year. The Company's provisional results for 2005-06 record 43 per cent increase in production of newsprint, which is 30955 MT as against 21680 MT in previous year. Similarly sale of 21818 MT of newsprint in previous year increased to 30370 MT showing 39 per cent improvement. The value of sale at Rs.58.85 in current year is 53 percent over the corresponding figure of Rs.38.47 Cr in previous year.

NEPA Limited has taken up various innovate measures for improvement in coming financial year 2006-07 under dynamic leadership of Brigadier SK Mutreja. Identification of vital components/spare parts, which are completely worn out, is being taken up for replacement in phases to improve the performance of the plant.

As cost cutting measure, for the first time in history of newsprint industry, transportation of old newspapers, basic raw material, has been done by Rail Wagons in third week of March 2006. The Company expects repetition of such action for maintaining continuous flow of raw material for sustained and regular production.

NEPA Limited has chalked out several schemes for oval improvement of plant, training of its manpower and automation of ill systems, which will be implemented in phases.
